





The motel is across the street from the restaurant and pool. Beverage machines located on each level of the motel poolside. The ice machine (for

motel guests only) is on the first level by the office (we do not supply ice for ice chests). The phone is in the first breezeway at the Motel.

Chalets These are A-frame cabins with 2 separate bedrooms, a large living/dining area, bath, and kitchen. Each bedroom has 1 queen bed. These have a TV which picks-up local channels only. These also have large glass windows that look out on a deck.

Deluxe 2 Capacity Cabins - These are our "honeymoon cabins". They have a screened porch with swing, and furniture. The bathroom has a whirlpooltub, they have a TV/VCR combination and other extras. The queen bed sits in the room with the fireplace.

HISTORY OF CHEAHA STATE PARK

The State of Alabama acquired eleven state parks in 1933 among these was Cheaha. Cheaha has continuously operated as a state park since 1933, making it the oldest continuously operating Alabama State Park. The official opening date for Cheaha State Park was June 7, 1939.

Between its acquisition in 1933 and its official opening in 1939, the ground work for the park was initiated and performed by the gallant men of the Civilian Conservation Corp., the "C.C.C.'s". The developments initiated and completed under the C.C.C. program included roads, stone cabins, bald rock lodge, the observation tower, picnic shelters, hiking trails, lake and beach facilities, bathhouses and other recreational areas. These C.C.C. facilities continue to be used by the public providing the nucleus of today's park.

In 1973, as increased demand for state park facilities escalated, a restaurant, hotel and chalets were added to the existing C.C.C. park facilities. Later in 1997 the cabins, motel and chalets were renovated to better serve this increased recreational demand.

Today, the C.C.C. facilities and the newer facilities both continue to serve the recreational needs of Alabama residents and tourists alike.

Cheaha Mountain is an extension of the Appalachian Mountain range and is the highest peak in Alabama at 2, 407 feet above sea level.

Cheaha State Park, which is prominently located atop the mountain, provides a most spectacular view of this rugged mountain range including the Talladega National Forest.

Upon gazing out upon this scenic mountain landscape, it is no wonder the Native American word "Cheaha", meaning "high place" was given to this mountain.

COUNTRY STORE - CAMPGROUND REGISTRATION

At the entrance of the main upper park area, the store offers gifts, beverages and supplies. The store also handles camper & pavilion registration. Inquire at the store for information on special events and Group tours of the park, or CCC Museum. CAMPGROUNDS-CHECK OUT is 11:00 am -Please inquire at the Country Store for registration and location information. Campers must be 18 years of age or older to register. There are 73 improved sites (43 in No. 1 and 30 in No. 2 Campground with full hook-up and bath house. There is a semi-improved area located by No. 1 Campground with tables and grills about 100 yards to Bathhouse (Please see map.) Primitive area has water only and it is 1/4 mile to bathhouse located in No. 2 campground (please see map). Reservations are advisable during peak season. A non-refundable deposit equal to one nights rental is required on reservations. Semi-Primitive and Primitive camp sites taken on first come, first served basis.

CHEAHA STATE PARK ACTIVITIES DAY USE AREA

OBSERVATION TOWER-Highest Point In Alabama. Closed at sunset.

HIKING-The Park has short trails with a wonderful view of the Talladega National Forest. Parking is available at the head of each trail. The Lake trail is very steep and should be traveled carefully when wet. Please see the map for further information on location of each trail. All trails in the park close at sunset.

FISHING-You must have a current Alabama Fishing License, if you are 16 years old or older. Purchase of Day Use Permit may be required. All over-night Guests may fish free at Cheaha Lake. Please inquire at the Country Store for further information.

CCC MUSEUM-Please inquire at the Country Store for hours and Group Tour information.

PICNIC AND PLAY AREA-located at the lake and close to the tower. Grills and tables available. Closed at sunset.

MOUNTAIN BIKE TRAIL-Cheaha Mountain Express- This 10 mile trail is moderate to strenuous. The surface is a rocky to smooth single track. The trail head starts at Park Entrance, booth on right. The second trail head is on the Bald Rock Road Loop. Configuration is out and back or loop. Please inquire at the Country Store for further information 1-256-488-5111.

SWIMMING:

LAKE-You can enjoy Cheaha Lake and it's sandy beach for sunning, swimming, and paddle boating.

Daily: June through August 9:00 am - 5:00 pm

The Park does not supply Lake/Swimming Pool Towels Hours may vary due to weather. Paddle Boat Rental is per hour. The lake may open on weekends or weekdays if possible. During Off Season, please inquire at the Country Store or Lake for further information.

POOL-Open May through August.
